

# Seaforth Day-Use Area

Located on Highway 64 west, Seaforth is one of Jordan Lake's four day-use areas. It offers a six-lane boat ramp with restroom/changing facilities, one 12-table picnic shelter (#9) with restrooms, a swim beach, paved parking, volleyball court, tot-lot, individual picnic sites with grills and a hiking trail.

- Seaforth is open year-round. Park hours:  
**May - August** 8 a.m. - 9 p.m.  
**March, April, September, October** 8 a.m. - 8 p.m.  
**November - February** 8 a.m. - 6 p.m.
- Entrance fees for this area:  
**\$6/car daily (Memorial Day through Labor Day)**  
**\$6/car weekends only (April, May and September)**  
**\$15/bus or van daily (Memorial Day through Labor Day)**  
**\$15/bus or van weekends (April, May and September)**
- Reservations are only accepted for the picnic shelter building. Parking spaces, adjoining beaches and restrooms are not included in the reservation.

- **No driving on the grass.**
- Loud music is not permitted.
- **Alcoholic beverages and firearms/weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited.**
- Park only in spaces provided on paved parking areas.
- Parking spaces are limited at the beach. When parking at the beach with **ANY** trailer, make sure to separate your trailer from your vehicle, taking up two spaces side by side.
- Pets are prohibited on the beach. Pets are allowed in other use areas; however, they must be on a leash not exceeding six feet in length and that leash must be under control of the owner.
- **No cans or glass allowed on the beach.** Plastic containers and thermoses are allowed.
- Park visitors may bring their own grills. Grills must be set up on gravel picnic sites or designated grill areas.


